

CODE OF CONDUCT – Rental Groups

Groups renting Parkside Ranch must agree to observe the following Code of Conduct:

- 1. Organizations using Parkside Ranch will allow a representative from the camp to bring official greetings and instructions regarding the use of the facilities and an explanation of the purpose of the camp at the first mealtime or upon arrival.
- 2. Each group must provide their own staff (speaker, program director, counselors).
- 3. Each group must provide their own supervision. At least one **competent adult** must be housed in each room and qualified adults must supervise each activity.
- 4. All vehicles must be parked only in designated parking areas to facilitate emergency access.
- 5. Girl's rooms are off limits to boys & vice versa except for family members during weekend retreats.
- 6. The contact person for the group (as indicated on the rental contract) must be on site for the duration of the booking period, and is the individual responsible for the groups' actions. This person is to **inform their group prior to arrival** about the camp's Code of Conduct.
- 7. Smoking is **NOT** permitted in any buildings and is **prohibited to anyone under 18**.
- 8. The following are **NOT** permitted anywhere on the premises:
 - a. Alcoholic beverages
 - b. Illegal drug products
 - c. Pornographic materials
 - d. Pets
- 10. Each person of the group is to be aware that immoral conduct, (any sexual relations outside marriage), profanity, or unsafe behavior, as determined by Parkside staff, will result in the immediate dismissal of the individual or the termination of the group's rental agreement and the group will be requested to vacate the premises immediately.
- 11. Damage to the environment (peeling trees, cutting saplings, littering, etc.) is not permitted.
- 12. If damage to the property occurs beyond normal wear, the group is responsible to reimburse Parkside for all costs, as determined by Parkside Ranch.
